
Quick Escape to the Aegean: Panagia Kryfti and Apergousa

This unique spot, designated as a Geosite of the UNESCO Global Geopark of Lesvos, will captivate you with its charm and beauty.



Kommenos Vrahos, Apergousa

Our final stop is at the eastern edge of Vatera Beach, at the picturesque Apergousa Beach. Here, you'll find the imposing Kommenos Vrahos (Cut Rock), which juts out into the sea, naturally dividing the beach into two golden shores. This idyllic setting offers the perfect opportunity to relax onboard with a glass of wine, accompanied by a curated Spotify playlist designed to enhance this romantic private sunset cruise experience.

The stunning sunset views, paired with local delicacies and wine, create the ultimate romantic getaway.
